

## 2022-2023 ECS School Supply Lists

We are excited and already looking forward to the 2022 - 2023 school year! This year we have broken supply lists out per grade and changed how supplies will be used in the lower grades. Accordingly, here are some key pieces of information:

1. K-2 supplies will remain at school; we recommend having a similar set of supplies for school-at-home work. The list included here only reflects the supplies needed for at-school work.
2. **Please bring all supplies for K-3 to Orientation Night and leave in your student's classroom in a clearly labeled bag with the student's first and last name.**
3. When brands are specified, it is because these are battle-tested, teacher-approved tools. Please do not substitute brands, sizes, or quantities unless unavoidable.
4. Per shared supplies this year, we are asking each family to contribute one box of tissues and one soap refill bottle (anti-bacterial and non-foaming). Then, families with a last name beginning with A-K, please bring a four-pack of large chisel-tipped dry erase markers (either black or a multi-color pack). Families with a last name beginning with L-Z, please bring one box/container of clear or white medium-sized kitchen garbage bags. Please bring these shared supplies to Orientation Night on August 25th.
5. Please check your child's supplies throughout the year and replenish or replace them as necessary.
